# In Order To Correct The Following

## • First or middle name, to add a first and middle name, or to switch the first and middle name:

- You will need all three of the following documents: the <u>affidavit to correct birth certificate</u>, <u>elementary school record/or census record</u> and a <u>record established as an adult showing full name and date of birth/or age of applicant</u>. Records established as an adult must have been established at least 5 years ago. If unable to meet these requirements then a Legal Name Change order will be required.
  - Examples
    - Marriage License
    - Voter's Registration
    - Military Discharge (DD-214)
    - Child's Birth Certificate

## Month or day of birth:

You will need all three of the following documents: the <u>affidavit to correct birth certificate</u>, <u>early school record</u>, and <u>a record established as an adult showing full name and date of birth of applicant</u>. If unable to obtain a school record then we will need multiple documents showing full name and date of birth, with one record established at least 10 years ago and other records established at least 5 years ago. If unable to meet these requirements then a court order, ordering the correct date of birth will be required.

# Misspelled last name:

 You will need the <u>affidavit to correct birth certificate</u> and a copy of your father's birth or marriage certificate. If in the mother's last name, you will need a copy of her birth or marriage certificate.

### • Incorrect last name:

Of the mother was not married at the time of birth, or married to someone else (step-parent) and the person has been using that last name since childhood, and the father is not listed on the birth certificate, you will need the affidavit to correct birth certificate, a copy of your school record of enrollment into elementary school (it must be your first school enrollment record) and also a record established as an adult showing name and date of birth. However, depending upon the individual circumstances, a court order is usually required to change the last name.

#### Year of birth:

You will need the <u>affidavit to correct birth certificate</u>, your <u>first</u> school record of enrollment into <u>elementary</u> school, and a census record.

### • Father's or mother's name:

 You will need the <u>affidavit to correct birth certificate</u>, and your father's or mother's birth or marriage certificate.

## • Gender:

o For all changes of gender <u>other than</u> sexual reassignment surgery, you will need the affidavit to correct birth certificate, and a copy of your marriage license, or a child's birth certificate.

#### Minors:

• We make corrections to a child's birth certificate within the first year without requiring proof or records. We will correct/change any item other than the child's last name. For all other corrections of minor's over 1 year of age, parents will need to complete the minor affidavit and supply a record established close to the child's birth that shows the child's name, date of birth and/or item to be corrected; or if it is a correction of the parent's information we will need the parent's birth certificate.
